

# Bar Harbor Yacht Club

## Rules

### Waterfront:

1. Our insurance requires that children under 12 must wear life jackets on the dock. Maine law states that children under 11 must wear lifejackets on boats.
2. Docked boat time limits - 15 minutes end, 1 hour sides. No unattended boats left on float.
3. Only club dinghies may be stored on the floats. Tie them securely.
4. If you own a dinghy, and it is not wooden, rubber, or plastic, it must have a rubrail. Tie your boat securely and with a short line. Put your oarlocks down and bail your boat regularly.
5. When removing trash from your boat, take it with you. Do not leave trash or returnables at the club.
6. The commercial use of Club facilities, in any form, is prohibited.
7. Guests using a member's boat or the clubhouse must be accompanied by a member.
8. All owners of boats owned in partnership must be members of the club.
8. Members living aboard their boats is strictly prohibited.

### Clubhouse:

1. When you are done using the clubhouse, leave it cleaner than when you found it and lock it up.
2. Take all of your own trash and returnables with you.
3. Model responsible behavior when using alcohol and do not leave alcohol unattended.

### Mercuries:

1. Boats are always available except during lessons.
2. Sign out or reserve boats on the clipboard in the sail locker.
3. Report any problems to Kate.
4. Take the time to leave boats in good order.
